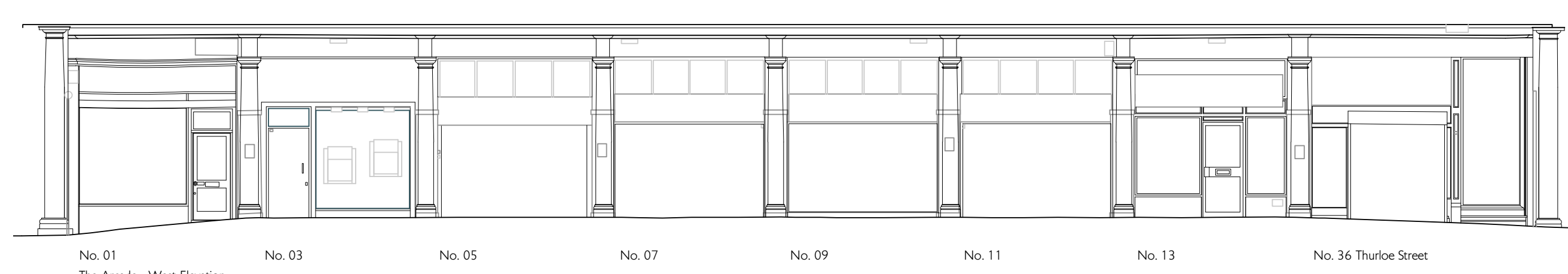

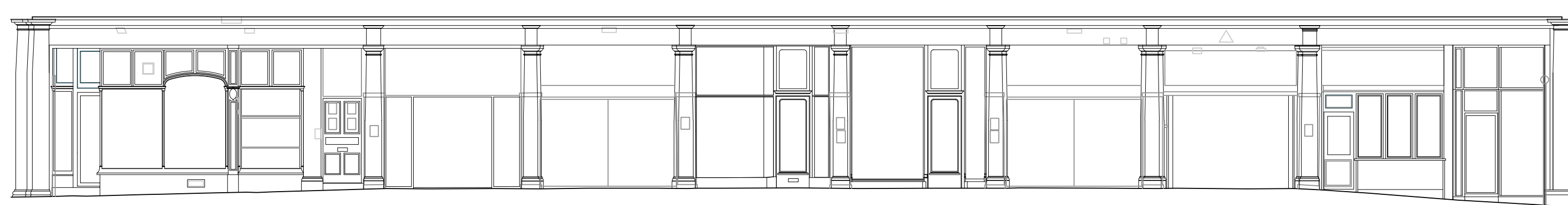


Colour rendering of a typical proposed new shopfront

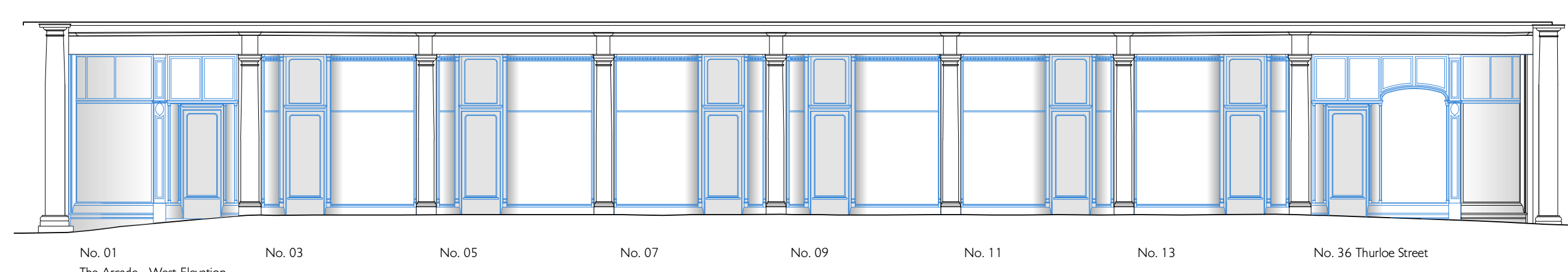

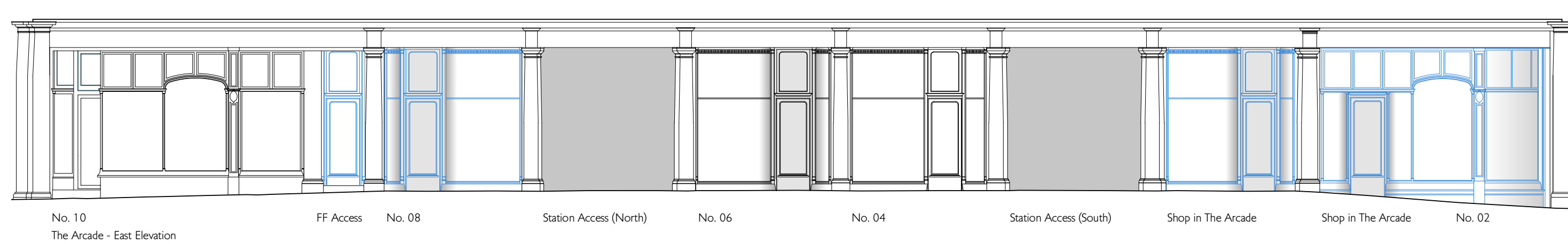
